General Description

A member is a physician or Scientist who is actively involved in the field of Advanced Body Imaging. Physicians who are board certified by the American Board of Radiology or the American Osteopathic Board of Radiology (AOBR) or who are Board eligible are eligible to become Members of the Society. Physicians outside the United States, who have their country's equivalent to the ABR or AOBR certification with an active interest in body imaging, are eligible to become Members of the Society. Non Physician Scientists with a doctoral degree who have finished training and who are engaged in the practice, teaching, or research of Advanced Body Imaging are eligible to become Members of the Society. On request, the membership committee may approve Scientist members who do not have a doctoral degree. International Members are eligible to submit abstracts to the Research and Science Committee as well as attend the Scientific Session.

Procedures for Admission

Applicants must submit an Application for Membership, which shall include a statement of interest as well as relevant background in the field of Advanced Body Imaging, which will be reviewed by the membership committee for admission.
